



JEAN PABIOT CUVÉE PRESTIGE DOMAINE DES FINES CAILOTTES 2012

If there is a producer that really knows how to make good wine then it is Jean Pabiot. From the end of the 20th century the Pabiot-family has worked the vineyards. Louis Pabiot started growing grapes alone with not even a horse in his 3HA vineyard. Around 1910 his son Gaston began working with him, buying horses and donkeys to work on the farm. In 1944 the house got named after little Jean Pabiot who was only 14 years old at the time, and he was the first to buy tractors transforming the wine production to the better. As for today the house is run by Jean's son, Alain, who is working as hard as all his predecessors before him to present you with the best of Domaine des fines Cailottes!

Pouilly-Fumé Cuvée Prestige 2012 is made from one of the best vintages and the grapes come from vines that are 40 years old or older. The vines are located close to Loges and grow in very rocky limestone clay terroir. The wine itself has a brilliant, light yellow color with white specks. Powerful nose of lime, grapefruit, smoke and dried fruit, with an underlying floral note. Supple, generous and full on the palate with notes of citrus and peach. An Pouilly with good minerality, wonderful complexity and harmonious style.

FOOD AND WINE PAIRING

Well suited as an aperitif. This wine is also paired well with chicken, fish, rabbit or mild cheese.
