A light, aromatic and transatlantic inspired beer. Velvety and fruity notes of Norwegian malt and American hops. Here, Rygr combines floor-malted barley from Jæren grains, malted with flaked wheat from Stangeland mill. They have chosen some of the most exclusive hops in the world, better known as centennial and mosaic. These are added to the beer in a very non-traditional way to give fruitiness.

Rygene - The grain farmers who built Rogaland. They were a population that in the ages of Vikings lived in the southwest, primarily in Rogland. Rygr has chosen 872 as "their" number, because this is traditionally considered the year for the sale of Hafsjord. It is therefore perhaps not surprising that when Jæren's next largest brewery is established, it happen in the middle of the grain fields and pioneers on Jæren, at close quarters with Lalandsholmens in Frøylandsvatnet, where the legend tells that Olav Tryggvasson Hårfagre's direct descendant was born.
